Hello Adventure Camp Families,

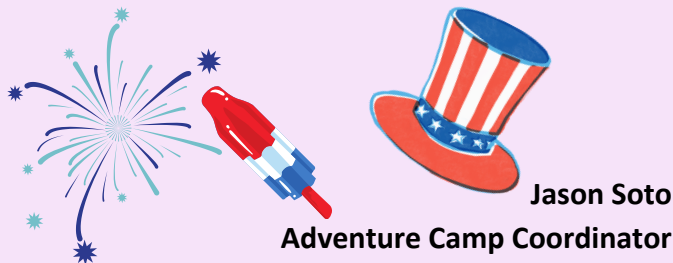
Happy 4th of July week.

Children should come with a reusable water bottle.

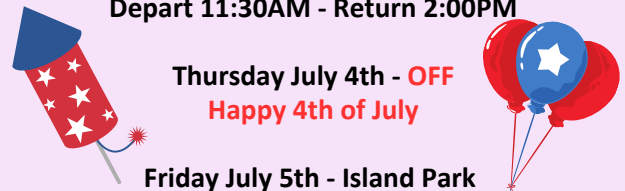
