### Angels Cheer & Poms Team requires a weekly commitment from 9/2024 through 8/2025.

While some scheduling issues cannot be avoided, please make every effort to plan family vacations and other commitments outside of required performance dates. We will make every effort to announce required dates ASAP. Participants who are unable to attend required performances or miss multiple practices may be removed from future performances.

\*Additional performance opportunities may arise throughout the season, and we will do our best to notify parents as soon as possible regarding any changes.\*



Please review the following Angels Cheer & Poms Team rules and guidelines and return to Coach Ryann no later than 9/9/24.

- I/we understand that the Angels Cheer & Poms team program is an 11-month commitment from September 2024-August 2025 and that weekly practice and performance are required the entire season (including summer).
- I/we understand that all cheerleaders will treat each other and their coaches with kindness and respect. Corrections and critiques will be given from coaches and should not be given from participants. Any cheerleader displaying unsportsmanlike behavior or unnecessary comments could be subject to dismissal from the program.
- I/we understand that practices and scheduled performances are mandatory.
- I/we understand that missing a practice the week of competition could result in cheerleaders being unable to participate in the performance. Illness or school events that require a grade may be considered as an exception.
- I/we understand that cheerleaders should arrive early and prepared to participate at all practices and performances. Late arrival could result in the cheerleader being unable to participate.
- I/we understand that cheerleaders should be picked up promptly after practices and performances. If you will be late to pick up your cheerleader, please call or text Coach Ryann or message via the Band app. If needed please call the office and get a message to the coach. Sunset Community Center 630-232-4542.
- I/we understand that all cheerleaders will be expected to behave and practice with their best effort at all times, taking corrections and maintaining a positive, respectful attitude. If a cheerleader acts inappropriately during class they will be asked to sit out and parent will be notified.
- I/we understand that cheerleaders should arrive in appropriate attire for practices. Attire for practices: T-Shirt or tank, shorts or jazz pants/leggings, cheer shoes, and hair tied back. Cheer shoes should not be worn on outdoor surfaces.

- I/we understand that participants are responsible for all required uniform purchases and fees must be submitted by the deadline. Late fees may be required or denial of participation may be necessary if payment is not received on time.
- I/we understand that competition fees must be paid by the instructed date in order to participate. Fees turned in after the instructed date will have a late fee or may not be accepted. Please keep in mind that competition fees are non-refundable. (This is the policy of all competitions).
- I/we understand that each cheerleader is responsible for their cheer items when at a competition or event. Any missing uniform pieces would result in point deductions at competitions, therefore the cheerleader may not be able to perform. Competition fees will not be reimbursed.
- I/we understand that cheerleaders and observers can be judged based on good sportsmanship towards other teams at all competitions and events. All participants, including parents, friends and family observers must show respect to other competitors at all events. Any cheerleader or observer may be asked to leave an event if they fail to demonstrate supportive and positive behavior.
- I/we understand that the Angels Cheer & Poms team is a no-cut team. However, coaches may divide groups by skills/ability. Coaches have the right to place team members in age/level groups they see fit.

I have read the Angels Cheerleading Handbook and understand that it is a **<u>binding</u>** <u>**contract**</u> holding me responsible for adhering to the above verbiage until the season ends in August 2024. I understand the dress code and class requirements. I understand the Competition requirements and expectations and agree to abide by these rules.
